1. Complete and submit the following forms by the March 1, 2012 deadline.

2. Include the required \$150.00 application fee (US Currency) with your application submission.

3. Visit Archbishop Riordan High School for a personal tour and interview prior to the March 1, 2012 deadline. International students may schedule a telecast or digital media based interview if they will not be in the United States prior to March 2012.

4. Register for the SSAT and / or TOEFL and have scores sent to Archbishop Riordan High School.

International Students

Thank you for considering Archbishop Riordan High School for your secondary education. The international student population at Riordan High School represents seven countries. Because Riordan High School does not offer a formal ESL Program, applicants must have a strong proficiency in the English language. We do offer an intermediate level of support through our English Emersion Program, which serves as a vehicle to help international students adjust to the academic and social environment of boarding school.

If an international applicant is accepted to Archbishop Riordan High School, we will issue an I-20 after we receive the signed enrollment contract and the required deposit. The family must designate an adult in the USA to act as a guardian for the student in the event of an emergency or to provide lodging during the school breaks.
