COUNSELOR ROLES IN COLLEGE PROCESS

Mrs. Nagar & Mr Williams COLLEGE COUNSELORS

- Advise and assist students throughout the college application process!
- Submits transcripts & recommendations to colleges.
- When applicable: Write the Counselor Recommendation or Secondary School Report (SSR).

Mrs. Martinez

- Provides academic/social emotional support.
- Available to review essays or CSU/UC Applications.
- Provides College Counselors supporting information for the Counselor Rec/SSR.
- When requested, can write CSU EOP recommendations.

IMPORTANT: When asked for counselor information on college applications, students should list their College Counselor's information.

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Application Requirements



CSUs Application Requirements

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY

CSU GPA:

- 2.5 Resident
- 3.0 Non-Resident
- Impacted Programs & Campuses will
- have higher requirements consider other supplemental factors.

For students that fall below minimum GPA, CSUs will consider additional supplemental factors.

TEST SCORES: Not Required or Considered for Admission (if provided, they will use for course placement).

APPLICATION AVAILABLE OCT 1st:

- No essay questions unless applying to Educational Opportunity Program (EOP).
- Self-reported courses & grades, and educational programs/work experience.

APPLICATION DEADLINE December 4th (11:59pm)

CSUs Supplemental Factors

Each campus will determine which factors are used. Supplemental academics will compose a minimum weight of 51%

Used by many campuses:

- "A-G" GPA
- "A-G" courses above 30/15
- Promise/Partnership programs
- First Generation
- Low Income
- Educational Programs
- Foster Youth Services
- Military Status

Less Frequently Used

- Math/Quantitative Reasoning GPA (STEM Impacted)
- Work Experience
- Extracurricular Activities
- Leadership Positions
- School Free & Reduced Lunch
- English GPA
- Lab Courses GPA (STEM)

UCs Application Requirements

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY

UC GPA:

- 3.0 Resident
- 3.4 Non-Resident

APPLICATION

- Self-reported courses & grades
- List Activities & Work Experience
- Respond to 4 Personal Insight Questions
- UC Berkeley By December, they Invite a select group of students to submit recommendations to support their application.

TEST SCORES: Not Required or Considered for Admission.

Test scores can be used later for placement.

Other College Requirements

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS VARY BY COLLEGE

 Consult your college counselor or look at average admit data from previous years

APPLICATIONS VARY BUT MOST REQUIRE:

- Essays
- Transcript
- Teacher Recommendations
- Counselor Report or Secondary School Report
- List of Activities & Work Experience

September 2020

*Colleges added to SCOIR after this date will require college counselor approval

What are Early Applications?

ED

Early Decision

This is a binding application, if you're admitted you must attend and withdraw other applications.

REA

Restrictive Early Action

Non-binding, but have stipulations for other kinds of applications that you can submit. Read the college's policy carefully!

EA

Early Action

You apply early to a school, and hear back early! It is not binding!

December 2020

- December 4th (11:59pm) Deadline for California State Universities (CSUs)
- **December 2020:** Application deadlines for some colleges especially for merit scholarships or art/music supplements. *Examples include:*
 - December 1: University of Southern California Merit Scholarship Deadline
 - December 1: Gonzaga U & Texas Public Colleges, Regular Decision Deadline
 - December 15: U of San Diego, Regular Decision Deadline

Spring 2021

January & February

Regular Decision Deadlines for some colleges.

California Community
College applications start
to become available.

March 2, 2021

FAFSA/CA Dream Act & Cal Grant Priority Filing Deadline for CSUs, UCs, and Community Colleges

April 1, 2021

Students should receive all application decisions by this date

(except for rolling applications)

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Candidate Reply Date for all colleges (SIR - Student Intent to Register).

Please update SCOIR once you know where you're attending!



June 2021

June 5th - Graduation

Mid- June: Registrar will automatically send your final transcript to the college that you've marked as attending on SCOIR.

Overview of College Rec Request Process

September 14 - October 9th

Window for students to submit College Rec Requests on SCOIR. Submit the request asap if you have an early application.

Deadline: October 9th

Teachers Respond to Requests

No later than October 14th, you'll receive a decision from your teacher.

Contact your College Counselor if your request is denied. **Submission of Materials**


Your College Counselor will submit your teacher recommendation to colleges listed in SCOIR on or around your deadline.



Requesting Transcripts & Recommendations for Colleges



When you've indicated that you've applied to a college on SCOIR, your counselor is notified and we send a transcript and/or teacher recommendations when they're ready!

SCOIR is the best way to notify us that you've applied and require materials! We are familiar with college requirements and will send the materials via the right platform.



Important Note: It can take colleges up to 2-3 weeks to process your materials and mark them as received in your portal.

Requesting Transcripts & Recommendations for Other Purposes
